Youth Covenant

A covenant is an agreed upon promise for the **benefit of the whole**.

- Because the activities for our retreat are meant to be group activities, no one, for any reason, can leave the activities or wander off alone. Because we want to become better friends with one another as a whole, no isolating yourself from the group.
- Be sure to use cell phone courteously. When you are asked to turn off your phone due to Bible study or other appropriate event then turn it off...this means no texting! If deemed necessary by the adults, cell phones may be collected and returned later.
- Because each one of us is created in the image of God, we believe life is sacred. Part of a Christian's responsibility is to protect others physically, spiritually, and emotionally. We strive to build others up in confidence and love, therefore respect each other—"Golden Rule" No vulgar language or crude joking. This includes shirt logos.
- Our bodies are a temple of the Holy Spirit and we are an example to the rest of the world for godliness. When we go swimming, appropriate swimwear is expected from both youth and adults. If attire is deemed inappropriate, a substitute will be provided. If you're not sure if what you have is appropriate...then don't wear it!
- ****Because each one of us is created in God's image, we do not want to harm ourselves in any way and because our actions speak louder than words, we will abide by the boundaries given to us by God and man: Therefore no drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or sexual misconduct. No activity which is against civil and/or federal laws, will be tolerated.**
- Pictures from youth activities may be posted on the church's website and/or the Children and Family Ministry Facebook Page, but images will not be tagged unless it is by the person(s) in the picture.

****Youth who choose not to comply with these expectations may be sent home.**

By signing this covenant, you understand and accept it. If you break a covenant, then you have moved beyond the boundaries of the group. Though we do not foresee a problem, we will strive for reconciliation between you and the group, appropriate consequences may ensue. **Let us help each other uphold this covenant so that we can have the best time possible!
