We have a mobile app. Vanco, our eGiving provider, has launched an app called Vanco Mobile. This mobile app replaces GivePlus Mobile. With Vanco Mobile, you can send onetime donations or set recurring gifts.

### How Do You Download Vanco Mobile?

It's easy. Head to the App Store or Google Play to download Vanco Mobile for free. Be sure to download this app because GivePlus Mobile no longer is available as of September 30, 2021.

To give using Vanco Mobile, first search for our church by name, then follow these five easy steps.

- 1. Select your gift amount, fund, and frequency.
- 2. Enter your payment method. (You can save this information for future use.)
- 3. Choose if you want to cover processing fees.
- 4. Click **Submit** to complete your donation.


